Permits for Permanent Outdoor Barbeques

INTRODUCTION

A permit is required for the installation of an outdoor barbecue if the barbecue has a chimney as defined below 4 feet or more in height, measured from the top of the cooking surface to the top of the chimney.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Factory-Built chimneys shall be installed in accordance with the terms of their listing, the manufacturer's installation instructions and the applicable requirements of the currently adopted codes.

Masonry and concrete chimneys shall be designed and constructed to comply with California Building Code, Section 3102.71.

GLOSSARY

Barbecue - a stationary open hearth or brazier, using electricity for food preparation, or using solid, gas, or liquid fuel for food preparation.

Chimney - a hollow shaft containing one or more passageways, vertical or nearly so, for conveying products of combustion to the outside atmosphere.
