Resolution authorizing the Chair, Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, to sign an agreement with the State of California, Department of Food and Agriculture for egg inspection for FY 2009-10.

Explanation (if required): None.

Prior Board Action: The Board has approved contracts with CDFG annually since 1979 for egg inspection activities.

Alternatives – Results of Non-Approval: No viable alternatives exist to provide Sonoma County necessary funds to meet this state mandated program. The County would not receive the \$10,813.96 necessary to partially offset the costs of the egg inspection program.

Background: This is an annual agreement which provides the Agricultural Commissioner subvention for the inspection of eggs for quality and size at production establishments, and wholesale locations.

Revenues for this program are generated by mill fees paid by egg packers in the state. Funds are subvented to counties based on the number of eggs packed in the county and the relative number of inspections performed. The Agricultural Commissioner will be reimbursed \$16.36 per 100 egg sample for a total of 661 samples (\$10,813.96). As is in past years, revenues from this agreement will not cover the full amount of expenses, but do partially offsets costs. The remainder of expenses for this program are included in the Departments FY 09-10 budget, and these expenditures will be subject to unclaimed gas tax revenue.
