RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SONOMA,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE
TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE
SONOMA COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL,
THE CITY OF PETALUMA POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE CITY OF SANTA
ROSA POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors desires to continue that certain program designated as the Sonoma County Auto Theft Task Force (SONCATT) to reduce the incidence of vehicle theft-related crimes in Sonoma County as adopted by the Board of Supervisors Resolution 92-1040 passed June 23, 1992; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Sonoma County Auto Theft Task Force (SONCATT) is allocated from revenues generated by the additional one dollar assessment on vehicle license fees authorized by Section 9250.14 of the Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that motor vehicle theft within Sonoma County has a highly negative impact upon the economy of Sonoma County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney's Office of the County of Sonoma is authorized, on its behalf, to execute the Fiscal Year 2009/2010 Memorandum of Understanding, including any extensions or amendments thereof which do not significantly change the program content and are within the approved budget authority
