## RESCUE BRANCH DIRECTOR

<b>Function</b>	Organize and direct rescue operations during the incident. Ensure a priority system of patient triage, extrication and movement to a safe treatment area is established. Coordinate with the Medical Branch and other sectors as needed.
<b>Report To</b>	Operations Section Chief, radio designation " <b>Operations</b> "
<b>Radio Designator</b>	Your radio designator is " <b>Rescue</b> "
<b>Subordinates</b>	Hazards, START, Extrication, Litters, Search, Tech/Spec
<b>Duties &amp; Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Obtain a briefing from the Incident Commander</li><li>▪ Make an assessment of the scene</li><li>▪ Identify and prioritize immediate, potential and future problems:</li><li>▪ Hazards</li><li>▪ Victims</li><li>▪ Extrication needs</li><li>▪ Hazardous Materials</li><li>▪ Resource needs</li><li>▪ Activate elements of the Rescue Branch as needed:</li><li>▪ Hazards</li><li>▪ START</li><li>▪ Extrication</li><li>▪ Litters</li><li>▪ Search</li><li>▪ Tech/Spec</li><li>▪ Coordinate with the Medical Branch Director to determine rescue priorities</li><li>▪ Monitor effect of power tool noise &amp; fumes</li><li>▪ Monitor location of unused equipment &amp; tools</li><li>▪ Maintain log of activities (ICS Form 214)</li></ul>
