**RE: LNU West Radio Programming Changes**

**In an effort to eliminate interference on LNU West from other areas, CDF will be changing the tones assigned to each mountain top repeater. These changes are scheduled to be in place by June 1, 2005. It is recommended that you make the changes as appropriate for your areas.**

**If you currently have your radios programmed with a specific mountain top, please be sure to change it to the new tones by June 1, 2005. Radios that currently have 16 tone capabilities should be the least affected by the changes.**

**Should you not be able to get through on LNU West, please contact REDCOM on your assigned control channel and request they contact CDF to come up on Command 1 or Command 2.**

**Please refer to the chart below for the new tones for each mountain top.**
