

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sonoma Local Agency Formation Commission will conduct public hearings at or after 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 10, 2009, in the County Administration Building, 575 Administration Drive, Room 102A, Santa Rosa, California, at which time all interested persons shall be given an opportunity to be heard on the following items:

1. File No. 09-06: Amendment No. 1 to the Sonoma County Water Agency Geyserville Sanitation Zone and Annexation No. 09-1 (Thomas/Dove) to the Sonoma County Water Agency Geyserville Sanitation Zone
2. Fiscal Year 2009-10 LAFCO Final Budget

The Sphere of Influence amendment and annexation request was initiated by Uma Thomas and Douglas Dove and is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Sections 15303(d), 15305, and 15319(b). The affected territory consists of one parcel, totaling 4.1± acres, generally located north of State Highway 128, east of Railroad Avenue, south of Petray Lane and west of River Lane, in unincorporated Geyserville.

The Fiscal Year 2009-10 LAFCO Final Budget is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3).

Copies of all related documents are on file and may be reviewed at the Sonoma Local Agency Formation Commission office. If you cannot attend the public hearings described in this notice, you may submit written comments prior to the hearings. If you challenge the actions of the Sonoma Local Agency Formation Commission on the review in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues raised at the public hearings described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Sonoma Local Agency Formation Commission at, or prior to, the hearing.

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS ARE HEREBY INVITED TO BE PRESENT AND HEARD ON THE MATTERS DESCRIBED IN THIS NOTICE.
